Dear Friends,

In Genesis 32 Jacob finds himself alone one



night and he begins wrestling with a stranger. They wrestle all night until the dawn begins to break. They find themselves in a stalemate, even after the stranger dislocated Jacob's hip. Jacob is dogged in his determination, and refuses to yield. Finally the stranger demands he be let go, but Jacob refuses unless the stranger "blesses" him. The stranger relents, and says "you shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel, for you have striven with God and with humans, and have prevailed." The stranger was an angel from God. Jacobs willingness to wrestle and refusal to give up impresses the angel.

Many of us spend all night, or all week, or all the time, wrestling with issues. We toss them around, roll around with them, try to get a grip on them. Sometimes our issues get the best of us. Sometimes we come out on top. But what is important is the struggle. A willingness to wrestle, struggle, engage with issues.

Far too often today, people want to avoid conflict. We run from issues and remain quiet

and simply accept things as they come. But some things need to be wrestled with; like faith. Faith is not easy. Faith is a choice that does not ensure smooth sailing, but instead promises we won't be alone in our boat. Most studies show the vast majority of Christians have a faith that exists on a third-grade level, and they are fine with that. They don't want to ask hard guestions. They don't wish to ponder difficult concepts. But wrestling with our faith causes us to understand it better. It causes us to examine our faith and pull out those pieces that don't sit well. Wrestling with our faith makes our faith stronger. Wrestling with your faith makes your faith deeper.

What part of your faith needs to be engaged this week. What part of your faith needs to be wrestled with, rolled around on the floor with, dissected and understood better? Where could your faith be strengthened by grabbing hold of it and grappling with what you believe and why? Don't take your faith lying down. Be willing to crawl into the ring with your beliefs and toss them around a little. You might be amazed at what you discover.


